## ONGOING LMPA PROJECTS

Weed Control – Working with the towns of Hopkinton, Upton and Milford as well as the Town of Hopkinton Lake Maspenock Weed Advisory Committee (Advisory Committee) to execute the Lake Maspenock Aquatic Vegetation Management and Control Plan that was developed by the Advisory Committee under guidance from the DPW and Board of Selectmen. Water Quality – A comprehensive monitoring plan was also developed by the Advisory Committee. Volunteers from the LMPA will be performing the monitoring activities in accordance with this plan.

Watershed Management – the LMPA is also working with the Advisory Committee to develop a comprehensive watershed management plan.
