\*Mike: Yes. Lot's of dead vegetation.

\*Jaime: Filing for extended draw down this year

\*Sabine: Joe Baldiga - CIG - did lots of work. We need to send out thank you letters.

\*Mike: Agree. We will all sign the letters

\*Mark: We need an address.

\*Sabine: Send Kerry one also.

#### **RiskManagement Plan Update**

\*Mike: Met with Kerry and Con. Com. re: Sustainability.

\*Complaints that there is not enough salt on the streets.

\*The real problem is drainage.

\*Ron's PP demonstration showed all this.

\*Sweep streets at the end of winter

\*Scott: Town is driven by safety first? Who is making that call?

\*Mike: Push for a low salt area. Ed Herrill Con. Com. or the Sustainable Committee.

\*Salt contributes to increase in weed growth.

\*The runoff from Price Chopper parking lot goes to North Pond basin from West Main Street.

\*Sabine: Extends to Pond Street that H2o is a concern . Should be part of risk assessment.

\*Phosphorus level is not an issue; salt is: Con. Com's. mind-sets need to shift.

Details: 7:50 \*Sabine: Next Wednesday (7/24/24) meeting with subcommittees (no longer ad-hoc). \*Will Burke is the new chair \*Seth Kenney is Vice-Chair \*Will speak with life/gate guard for feedback.

\*There are or pontoons on the lake

\*Gate guards are 14-15 year olds letting people, who are not residents, in.

\*Handing out passes (all are the same color)

\*Perhaps they could be three separate colors to differentiate between person, car, boat trailer.

\*Needs to be different colors every year.

\*Police aren't ticketing

\*Swimming is happening outside of the swimming area during guard time.

\*Somebody tried to bribe a life-guard with alcohol; the guard gave the person a pass because he was frightened.

\*Sabine called the police; they spoke with the life-guard and two women

\*Police did little to address issue

\*Mike: Three drownings; none were residents

\*Two were Swimming out of view

\*Expired permits

\*Maureen is the supervisor of P&R - she should be the contact person

\*Mike: At Hopkinton State Park there are two police with signs we are closed. They are town and state employees

\*Sabine: requested detail for after 5:00pm

\*Mike: Spoke with Kerry regarding the gate. Easier to control the boat ramp. In the past, it was closed off at night and re-opened in the early a.m.

\*Scott; State law - access to lake

\*Yvonne: Dropping people and boats off at the old abandoned dock.

\*Sabine: Community Advocate: Lake Quinsigamond has one re: jet skis.

\*Mike: No restrictions. Lake is non-restrictive.

\*Sabine: Hop News: Highlight non-resident issue about the jet skiers.

\*Jaime: Hop News is local. Not worthwhile. Need to address the issue with the Police, P&R, Education.
