- Dock: funding and permit approved. Will be installed around Memorial Day weekend.
- Safety Bin: Everything needs to be Coast Guard approved
- Sandy Beach Lifeguard applications: P&R is hiring.
- Day passes are sold at the beach.
- Season passes: go in person P&R with a license to buy passes or purchase online.
- Discuss what police will enforce
- Advise what signage will help us enforce rules
- Hire police to help monitor, especially at start of season,
- Hire police from 5:00pm-7:00pm to be in parking lot
- Lifeguard - parent-child safety course in parking lot
- Reverse direction to enter/exit to park boat trailers
- Works the way it is now; trial and error now before parking lot is redone
